Dr Agha is treating at her clinic more than **600 diabetic patients**.

He is also suffering from hypertension. We provided him with Metformin 500 mg. He said 'I am grateful to you for helping me out, as these medications are running me out of money the whole month!'



Mrs Turkiyyeh Ismail,
a 67 years old diabetic patient

who discovered that she has diabetes since 6 years. She is taking Actos medication for diabetes which is not on the drug list of UNRWA. She has to buy it monthly at 50,000 L.L. in addition to other medications. She said it is more expensive than Meat.. We provided her with Actos and Metformin which we got through our medical in-kind donation program with our donor ANERA.
